Tashkent Textile Week, an important event in Uzbekistan's textile sector, brings together specialists from both the local and international textile industries in Tashkent.

An international forum, an industry textile and fashion exposition, trainings on the most recent trends and news in the industry, business and press tours, as well as B2B meetings with the participation of the top companies in the world are all included in this significant textile event.

The 6th international textile and fashion expo **UzTextileExpo Spring 2023** will open on May 29 to kick off textile week. This event, which is anticipated to draw more than 9,000 experts, will highlight the successes and most recent advancements in the sector. In particular, more than ten German companies and manufacturers will take part with a national display for the first time, following a high-level visit to Germany. The exhibition also included the national pavilions of Belarus and India.

An official launch ceremony for a new collaborative initiative supported by the German government will take place during the week, along with a briefing organized in conjunction with the German Textile Confederation.

On May 30, the Tashkent Textile Forum will be held, along with the "II International Conference" of the Confederation of Employers of Uzbekistan, with the support of the International Labor Organization, the UN European Development Commission, the German organization GIZ, and the International Federation of Textile Manufacturers. Participants will include the major industry manufacturers, retailers, investors, and representatives of international organizations.

The subjects of "Social Entrepreneurship", "Secrets of Sustainable Production", "Digitalization. Transparency of the Supply Chain", and "Digitalization In Modern Textile Technologies" will all be covered in panel sessions.

training program includes sessions on The week's topics like "Development of Women's Entrepreneurship in the Textile Industry", "Supplier Requirements: New Realities of Exports to the EU", "Textile and Fashion: Trends and Forecasts for 2023-2024", "the Art of Management and Innovative Manufacturing Solutions", "Textile Trends and Innovation", "Merchandising", "The Creation and Evaluation of Corporate Governance in Clusters", and "The Art of Management and Innovative Manufacturing Solutions".

For the first time, Fiber2fashion, the largest international publication in the world of textiles, will take part as an information partner of the week. In addition, press tours to different regions of the republic are organized for foreign and local journalists.

Within a week, local enterprises can conclude new export contracts, get acquainted with new projects and cooperation solutions, and widely demonstrate their products to representatives of more than 40 countries around the world.
